Carl has led dozens of pioneering digital research projects, ranging from early warnings about online conspiracy theories and the challenges of digital literacy, to insights into cryptocurrencies, policing transformations, and the advent of SOCMINT—social media intelligence. His investigations have mapped the rise of digital politics, tracked online abuse against

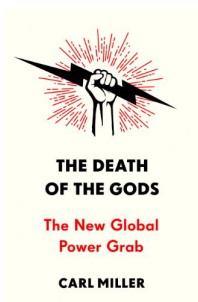
