Careers rarely move in straight lines any more. Senior professionals, founders and performers are asked to reinvent themselves several times in a working life, often under public scrutiny and without a clean narrative to justify the pivot. The people who manage it well tend to treat reinvention as a discipline rather than a moment, combining new commercial ventures with a continuing reputation in the one that made their name.

Tamer Hassan is a British actor and entrepreneur who uses his own reinvention across film, hospitality and media to illustrate how profile, risk and commercial judgment can be rebuilt at each stage of a career.

- His acting career gives him immediate name recognition with audiences, with credits across *The Football Factory*, *Layer Cake*, *Batman Begins*, *Kick-Ass*, *Clash of the Titans*, *Eastern Promises* and *Game of Thrones*, which is useful for headline slots and mixed-audience events where draw matters.
- He has built a parallel business career rather than a vanity one, as Director of the NASDAQ-listed Lottery.com since June 2023 and President of Sports.com Studios since June 2025, giving him a live operator's view of the economics of sport, content and media.
- The hospitality and nightlife background, including his investment in Karma Sanctum Soho alongside Paul Oakenfold, is the foundation of a reinvention story that is specific, commercial and not sanitised.
- He brings an unusual mix to panel and Q&A formats: a performer's comfort in a room, an investor's view on deal structures, and a sharp commercial instinct sharpened by running hospitality businesses in London.
- His philanthropic profile, including support for Covid-19 frontline workers and Turkey-Syria earthquake relief, gives him useful credibility in charitable and fundraising contexts where a recognised name is required.

Biography

A career that began in London amateur boxing and hospitality has ended up, so far, on the board of a NASDAQ-listed company and at the front of a new sports content studio. Tamer Hassan's reinvention story is the point of the speaking work, and it is specific enough to hold an audience because each stage was paid for by the one before.

He was born in New Cross in 1968 to a Turkish Cypriot family and came through the south-east London small-business world before acting. His breakthrough role, as the leader of the Millwall firm in *The Football Factory* opposite Danny Dyer, set the tone for a 25-year screen career that has since included *Layer Cake*, *The Business*, *Batman Begins*, *Eastern Promises*, *Kick-Ass*, *Clash of the Titans*, *Game of Thrones* and *Snatch*.

Alongside the acting, he kept building businesses. Karma Sanctum Soho, the boutique Soho hotel he co-developed with Paul Oakenfold, gave him a base in hospitality and a reputation in London's night-time economy. Since June 2023 he has been a director of Lottery.com Inc. (NASDAQ: LTRY), and in June 2025 he was appointed President of its Sports.com Studios division, leading the company's new film, docuseries and original programming strategy.

For event audiences the draw is the combination. Few speakers can discuss a long screen career and an operator role at a listed company in the same session, with a personal story that runs from London boxing gyms to Turkey-Syria earthquake fundraising. The value is in the trajectory, and in the unguarded way he tends to explain it, rather than in a named intellectual framework.
